VANGUARD CULTURE DEBUTS ITS 2019 SEASON: “CATALYST,” ENGAGING THE VISUAL, PERFORMING, AND CULINARY ARTS

LAUNCHING AN ARTS RESIDENCY IN THE EAST VILLAGE, THE NONPROFIT PRESENTS AN INSPIRING CULTURAL CALENDAR

SAN DIEGO, CA (December 17, 2018) — [Vanguard Culture](#), a 501(c)3 nonprofit dedicated to advancing San Diego’s Creative Industries, will launch its 2019 season, *CATALYST*, at its new headquarters at IDEA1 in the [I.D.E.A. District](#). The season will include spoken word, live music and dance performances, costumes and high fashion, film screenings, professional development for creatives, delicious food, craft beer, cocktails, and amazing wine from the Valle de Guadalupe.

The first event of the season will take place on January 19, 2019 with [Making Dance: The Future Starts Now](#), in partnership with the San Diego Symphony, Malashock Dance, and Space 4 Art. Dance icon John Malashock will create new choreography to live music written and performed by San Diego Symphony 'Hearing the Future Festival' Director Matthew Aucoin. Guests will have an opportunity to see the creative process live while sipping on craft cocktails and delicious wines from the Valle de Guadalupe. The event includes a post-show pop-up art experience themed around “sound” and “the future” by the local artist collective Space 4 Art. \$20-\$25

To curate its exciting 2019 *CATALYST* season, Vanguard Culture hosted visioning meetings with its cultural and community partners to design a variety of engaging and innovative events that create arts jobs, bring diverse communities together, and inspire creative collaboration.
